

The Culver City Unified School District (District) and The Culver City Federation of Teachers (CCFT) have agreed to the following:

Health and Welfare

Effective January 1, 2018, there will be a \$232 increase to the annual cap for CCUSD health insurance benefits.

Article 23: Early Retirement

The District will offer an early retirement incentive of \$20,000 to those retirees who meet the district established criteria. The criterion is as follows:

- 1. The employee must be at least age 55 with 10 years with the district and be at least 80 percent. Retirement incentive will be prorated for those retirees who work less than 100%.
- 2. The one-time bonus will be paid upon separation from the District. Retirement effective date cannot be later than June 30, 2018.
- 3. Retirement incentive checks will be dispersed in July 2018.
- 4. The employee must notify the CCUSD Human Resources Office in writing of their intent to retire by June 30, 2018.
- 5. A minimum number of 10 teachers must take advantage of the retirement incentive to be eligible for this one-time bonus. In the event there are less than 10 teachers who declare their intent to leave, the employee(s) may rescind their notice without penalty.
- 6. 10 teachers must continue to stay committed to retirement in order for the District to move forward with the incentive.
- 7. The District will announce the number of employees who wish to retire by April 15, 2018.
