For Owner-Occupants Age 65 as of June 30, 2021

On November 6, 2018, the registered voters of Culver City approved Measure K. Measure K is an annual education parcel tax levied per parcel for seven years. The funds will maintain small class sizes, retain qualified teachers, support essential educational programs, and improve support for students with special needs in Culver City schools.

Measure K allows property owners of any parcel of taxable real property owned and occupied by at least one person **65 years of older** to apply for a Senior Citizen Exemption. To qualify for the Senior Exemption from the Parcel Tax, you must: 1) turn 65 years old before June 30, 2021 and, 2) own and occupy your property as your primary residence.

How to Apply for the Measure K Senior Citizen Exemption

- Applications are available electronically, by email, by request, or in person:

 - o Call the Parcel Tax Administrator at (844) 332-0549 for application by mail; or
- Complete the Measure K Senior Citizen Exemption Application and include the following documentation (copies only):
 - o Proof of ownership (property tax bill)
 - Proof of residence (utility bill)
 - o Proof of birth date (driver's license, birth certificate, or passport)
- Completed applications and required documents are due by June 30, 2021:

Once your exemption is approved, the exemption will be automatically renewed as long as you continue to own and occupy the residence.

If you sell your home and purchase a new home, you must re-file for a Senior Citizen exemption for the new property.
