

# Learn to Make a Charm Bracelet

## Supply List

Instructor: Renée Raymond

1. You will need the following jewelry making tools:•
  - chain nose pliers
  - round nose pliers
  - wire cutters: also known as “flush cutters,” “side cutters” or “nipper tool”
  
2. Bring BEADS:•
  - You’ll need approximately 10-20 beads of your choosing.
    - Pick colors and shapes you really like.
    - Select crystal, gemstone, glass, or wood beads.
    - The best size would be **6mm** (the size of a pea) up to a size **10mm** (the size of a marble). Anything larger and your bracelet may be uncomfortable to wear – but if that’s what you want, go for it! I like using size **8mm**.
  
3. Other items:
  - ruler
  - reading glasses, if you need them

Your materials fee includes metal charms, headpins, jump rings, chain, a clasp, and a ring blank. Some of the charm themes provided will be: Love, Sea, Celestial, Garden, Luck, Flowers, Hearts, Crosses, & Skulls.
