



Areas of Overlay and Difference (Attachment A)

- FLAP goals are as follows.
 - <u>Japanese</u>: Provide one elective and one subject course in Japanese
 - Spanish: Articulate existing K-12 courses in Spanish to create a defined pathway for immersion students
- FLAP personnel accountable to FLAP goals.
- Resources (Professional development, materials, etc.) must meet goals for K-12, not just secondary.

Recommendations by the Strategic Planning Committee

- Subject courses to be added to the MS and HS via a Phase-In Process
- Pending Opening in a Secondary Subject Course, new hires in the district to be Japanese and Spanish Single-Subject Language AND Core-Subject Certified
- Create a Task Force that will gather information and make recommendations to the Board
