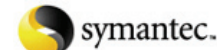

- Innovative block scheduling maximizes instructional time and promotes curriculum enhancement
- Interdisciplinary teaming of students promotes small learning communities for students and collaboration among teachers

Culver City Independent Study Program is an accredited K-12 school providing an alternative, highly-individualized educational option offering:

- A credentialed teacher who works on a one-to-one basis with students
- A learning experience which emphasizes independent study skills, acceptance of personal responsibility for course completion and academic success
- Follows curriculum content standards that are state and district wide in grades K-12
- Provides individualized programs which maximize the opportunities for all students to successfully transition to higher education or the workforce
