



The following information is provided as a courtesy of the Culver City Police Dept. Parking and traffic officers will be providing enforcement at Culver City schools and issuing citations for state and municipal code violations. We are dedicated in our efforts to raise the awareness of child safety and improve the traffic flow around Culver City schools.



Red Curbs

Vehicles are not permitted to use red curbs at any time, including for the use of loading and unloading passengers. All observed violations may be cited, including the obstruction of fire hydrants. **FINE: \$80-120**

By properly following these rules, drivers should have little difficulty when dropping off and picking up students within the school district.

Intersections & Crosswalks



Drivers are not permitted to stop/park within an intersection or over a crosswalk to load or unload passengers. This practice creates a hazard as other vehicles attempt to go around and/or obstructs pedestrians from properly crossing the street. **MINIMUM FINE: \$200**

Double Parking



Drivers are not permitted to stop/park in a traffic lane **at any time**, especially for the purpose of loading or unloading passengers. This practice creates not only a traffic hazard by creating a vehicular backup, but also jeopardizes the safety of children who may run into the middle of the street. *All* vehicles that are observed using the traffic lane as a loading/unloading zone may be cited. **MINIMUM FINE: \$60**

Passenger Loading

All vehicles in this area must be **actively** loading or unloading passengers. Drivers will not be permitted to stop/park in this zone to wait for children. Any unattended vehicle may be cited immediately. If a driver needs to leave the vehicle, it is highly recommended that they park legally on an adjacent street and walk to the school. **FINE: \$50**
