PRE-OFFER DRUG/ALCOHOL TESTING

The Governing Board maintains a drug and alcohol-free workplace. In accordance with law, all employees are required to render service without using, possessing, being impaired by or being under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

(cf. 4020 - Drug and Alcohol-Free Workplace)

Once conditionally placed on an employment eligibility list, prospective employees in the following classifications shall undergo a pre-offer drug and alcohol screening for any substance which could impair their ability to safely and effectively perform their job functions:

- 1. School Bus Driver
- 2. Security Guard
- 3. Biology/Chemistry Teacher
- 4. Wood Shop Teacher
- 5. Metal Shop Teacher
- 6. Plastic Shop Teacher
- 7. Grounds Equipment Operator
- 8. Kitchen Personal (Foods)
- Maintenance Workers
