# TB TEST REQUIREMENTS

### Who Needs a Skin Test?

Students who have <u>never</u> attended a California school must present written evidence of a Mantoux (PPD) skin test. Multiple puncture tests <u>are</u> not acceptable.

- 1. All kindergarten students (preschool does not count). Test must be given within one year prior to school entry.
- All other students in grades 1-12 who have never attended any school in California.
  Please Note:
  - 1. This test could have been performed at any previous time.
  - 2. If the student previously attended any California school (public, private or parochial), the student is exempt from this requirement.

## What Does a Student Bring to School?\*

A form from the doctor or health facility with the following information:

- 1. Type of test. Mantoux (PPD) only. Multiple punctures are <u>not</u> acceptable.
- 2. Date of test.
- 3. Skin Test Results.
  - A. Skin test reading must be done by a health provider.
  - B. Negative is acceptable if reading is less than 10 mm.
  - C. If skin test result is 10 mm or more of induration (positive), written indication of x-ray date and/or statement that the child is free of communicable TB is required.
- 4. Signature of doctor of designee.

#### Please Note:

- 1. A chest x-ray instead of a skin test is not acceptable unless the doctor medically waives the skin test.
- 2. Students with a history of BCG must have a skin test unless the doctor certifies in writing that the child is free of communicable TB.
- 3. A child age 12 or older may sign consent for TB skin test or x-ray.
- 4. The Mantoux test should be given prior to, or simultaneously with, measles (MR,MMR) vaccine. If a measles vaccine has already be given, the Mantoux should be deferred for one month as this may cause a false negative result. The child should be admitted to school conditionally for that month.
- 5. A child with a positive skin test can be admitted conditionally for up to 20 school days while awaiting chest x-ray clearance.
