INTERSCHOLASTIC COMPETITION

Health and Safety

District employees shall take every possible precaution to assure that athletic equipment is kept in safe and serviceable condition.

Equivalent Opportunities

The district may provide single sex teams where selection for teams is based on competitive skills. (Code of Regulations, Title 5, Section 4921)

When a school provides only one team in a particular sport, and if athletic opportunities in the total program were previously limited for students of one sex, members of both sexes shall be allowed to tryout for the team. (Title 5, Section 4921)

Parental Notifications

Before a student participates in interscholastic athletic activities, his/her parents/guardians shall receive a notice which:

1. Explains that there is an element of risk associated with all athletic competition and that the district cannot ensure that any student will not be injured, despite the staff's commitment to provide every participant with due care.
2. Requests parental permission for the student to participate in the program and be transported by the school to and from competitions.

Explains that it is imperative that the student adhere strictly to all safety rules, regulations and instructions.
