SUMMER SCHOOL

BP 6177

The Governing Board recognizes that summer school provides valuable opportunities for students to improve their skills and make academic progress. When the need is demonstrated and funds are available, the Superintendent or designee, with Board approval, shall establish summer school day and/or evening classes for purposes of remediation, enrichment or acceleration.

Admission

First priority to enroll in core academic summer high school classes shall be given to district students who need course credits in order to graduate by September or who were assessed as not meeting the district's adopted standards of proficiency in basic skills.

Remaining summer high school openings in core academic subjects shall be open to private school students to the extent that space is available after district students have enrolled.

The remaining openings in these classes shall be offered on a first- come first-serve basis.

Attendance

Because courses taught during the summer condense and concentrate the instructional content of those courses offered during the regular school year, faithful attendance during the summer session is crucial.

Students who have more than three excused absences shall not receive credit for their summer session class(es) .

Students who have more than one unexcused absence shall not receive credit for their summer session class (es) .

Exceptions may be made by the administrator
